Advisor to the Minister of Foreign Affairs and previously director general, political director (2013 – 2016), Gheorghe Magheru has joined the diplomatic service in 1990.

Ambassador, Permanent Representative of Romania to the Council of Europe (2001 – 2006) he has chaired the Committee of the Ministers Deputies of the Strasbourg organisation during the tenure of the Romanian Chairmanship (2005).

Several times director general or director for global, regional or bilateral affairs, Gheorghe Magheru is currently Governor for Romania in the Asia – Europe Foundation (ASEF) since 2009.
