

**Mr. Sorin Cîmpeanu, chairman of the The National Rectors' Council, Romania**

*Sorin Mihai Cîmpeanu* is Professor of the Faculty of Land Reclamation and Environmental Engineering at the University of Agronomic Sciences and Veterinary Medicine of Bucharest.

Since the graduation of the same faculty, Sorin Mihai Cîmpeanu has been dedicated to the field of education by becoming a PhD in Agronomy and then occupying academic grades to the full professor position. At the same time he is involved in scientific research activities by implementing a lot of national and international projects as project director or expert consultant.

Remarkable through a very good experience in the field of education occupies the position of Dean of the Faculty of Land Reclamation and Environmental Engineering and becomes the Rector of the University of Agronomic Sciences and Veterinary Medicine of Bucharest since 2012.

During 2000-2003 was expert coordinator of the National Centre for "Leonardo da Vinci" and between 2003-2004 he had the similar position at the National Agency for the Partnership of the Universities with the economic and social environment (APART) within the Ministry of Education and Scientific Research.

Sorin Mihai Cîmpeanu occupied the position of Minister of Education and Scientific Research, Interim Prime Minister of the Romanian Government and Interim Minister of Internal Affairs.

Starting 2016 is a Deputy of the Romanian Parliament.

Mr. Cîmpeanu is the President of the National Council of Rectors in Romania, second mandate, and it holds the title of Doctor Honoris Causa of the two universities in Romania.

Sorin Mihai Cîmpeanu received the distinction of "Year Personality for an European Romania" awarded by the European House, medal „Skill for the Education” awarded in 2004 by the President of Romania (Decree 1097/10 dec. 2004) and the national prize “In Hoc Signo Vinces” awarded for the research activity by the National Council of Scientific Research of Superior Education.

Mr. Cîmpeanu was also elected as the President of the Agence Universitaire de la Francophonie (Francophone University Association) for a mandate between 2017-2021.
