- low level relations between NATO and Russian Federation
- annexation of Crimea, generating a reconfiguration of Europe's map
- NATO's most important military consolidation process after the Iron Curtain fall
- unpredictable, transnational and multinational character of the security environment

- allied forward presence in the Black Sea region
- integrating of the US BMD system deployed in Romania into the NATO's BMD system

for the entire Eastern flank of the Alliance**

ROMANIA'S FORESIGHT FOR AN ALLIED PRESENCE ON THE SOUTH-EASTERN FLANK

- proactive posture and substantial initiatives
- significant national contribution, augmented by the allied states efforts within region;
- enhance the existing multinational training frameworks with the allied states within the region, and also with the partner states.

DEFENCE STARTS AT HOME

ROMANIA'S PROPOSALS

- a framework for an allied naval presence in the Black Sea;
- an Army Multinational Brigade on the national territory;
- a framework for a Combined Joint Enhanced Training – CJET.

Romania is not aiming for offensive actions!
