A career diplomat, he joined the Romanian MFA in 1990 where he pursued his activity till retirement. He held a wide range of managerial positions as director and director general for global, regional and bilateral affairs.

As Ambassador, Permanent Representative of Romania to the Council of Europe (2001-2006), he chaired the Ministers' Deputies Committee of the Strasbourg based human rights organization during Romania's tenure in 2005.

Political director (2013-2016), Advisor to the Minister, he was Governor for Romania in the Asia Europe Foundation (ASEF) between 2009-2020.
